Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF) Star Ratings

The Nevada Department of Education (NDE) has resumed calculating the NSPF Star Ratings. The Index Scores provided for all NSPF indicators and measures were calculated using accountability data from the 2022-23 school year.

School Designations and Exit

The NDE designated schools for Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) and Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) based on 2022-23 school year student performance data. In summer 2023, CSI schools were evaluated for possible exit.

Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rates (ACGR)

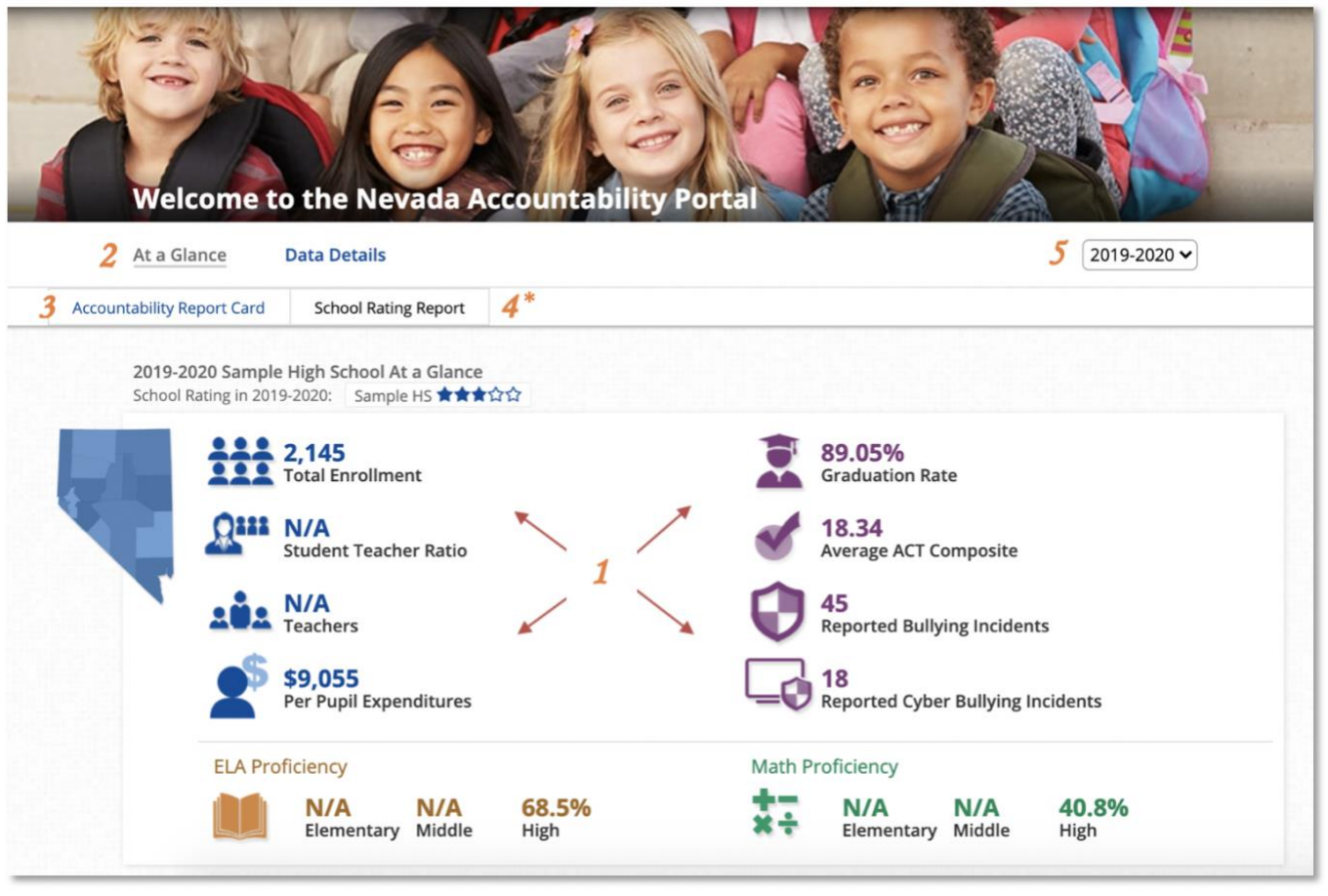
ACGRs have been calculated with one major change in the process: the exclusion of the Adult Diploma from the graduate student category. This change was necessary to comply with the USDOE requirement to exclude adult diplomas as adult diplomas not being awarded to a preponderance of students (less than 1%) in the State. Adult diplomas will continue to be counted as a Nevada diploma which evidences a person's graduation from high school who has met the requirements of graduation as defined in NAC 390.018.

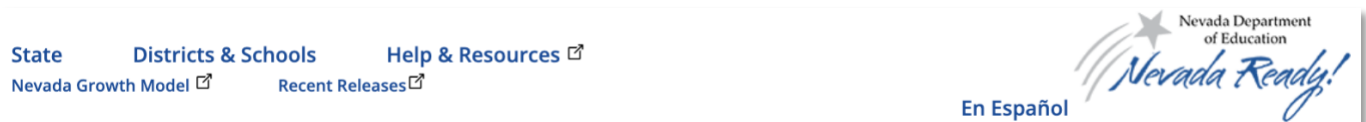

What does my school rating mean?
Three-Star school: Identifies an **adequate school** that has met the state's standard for performance. The all-students group has met expectations for academic achievement. Subgroups meet expectations for academic achievement or show progress with little exception; however, no group is far below standard. The school must submit an improvement plan that identifies supports tailored to subgroups and indicators that are below standard. Schools identified for comprehensive support and improvement are not eligible to be classified as a three star school or higher. Schools identified for targeted support and improvement are eligible to be classified as three star schools.

About the Alternative Performance Framework

The APF is intended to collect and report additional performance data for alternative schools where at least 75% of the enrollment is comprised of students with unique needs. Schools usually fall into one of four categories: schools offering credit recovery programs; schools offering behavioral/continuation programs; Juvenile Detention Facilities providing services to adjudicated youth; and Special Education schools serving students identified as having significant cognitive disabilities. Some APF schools include grade levels that cross the typical elementary, middle, and/or high school configurations. The APF Report compiles data for all grade levels represented in the school.

School Mission

The mission of the Education Program for the Summit View Youth Center is to work cooperatively with DCFS personnel to provide credit/credit recovery educational programs that will help all youth obtain a Standard Diploma according to the requirements of the Nevada Department of Education. This will occur in a safe and supportive learning environment where students will be motivated to work to their potential.

Continuum of Performance

School Narrative: SVHS provides both high school diploma and HSET options. Approximately 90% of students are credit deficient and about 35% have an IEP. Our goal is to graduate students whenever possible, before they exit the facility. For younger students, the goal is to gain credit sufficiency before exit.

Academic Achievement

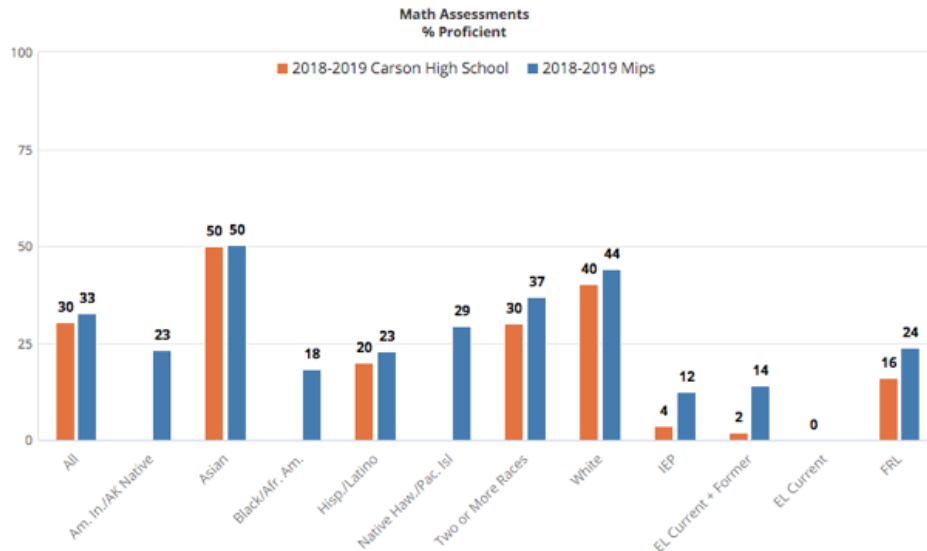
Academic Achievement is a measure of student performance based on a single administration of the State assessment. Cut scores are set to determine the achievement level needed to be proficient on the assessment. Points are earned based on the percent of students proficient in the areas of English Language Arts (ELA), Math and Science based on the ACT, Nevada Science, and Nevada Alternate assessments.

Schools need to have ten records in the "all students" group to receive points. Any subgroup with an assessed population less than ten will not be reported on the given Measures. Only students who have been enrolled at the school at least half the year will be included in the Measures in this Indicator.

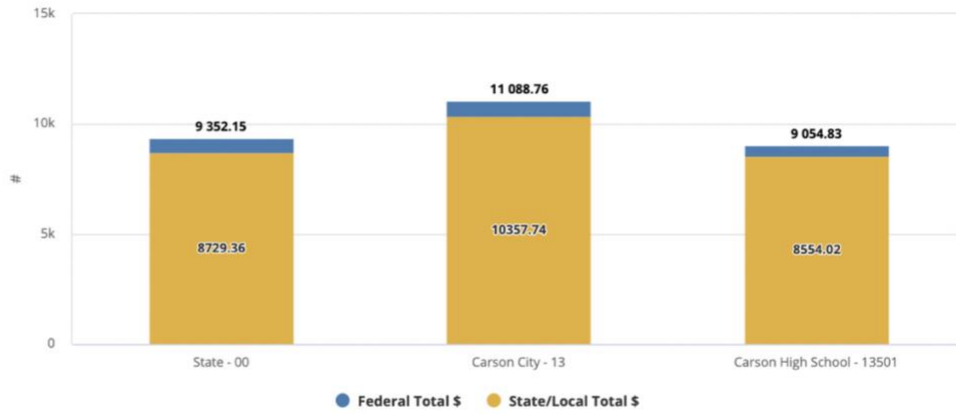

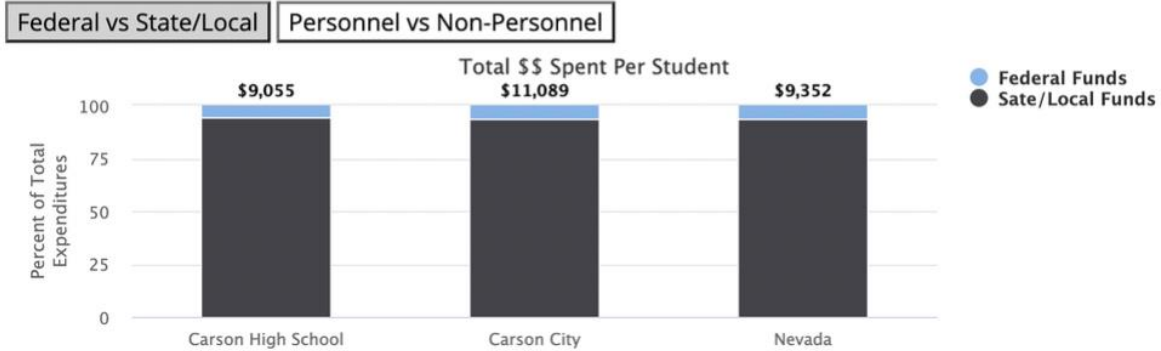

Dollars Spent Per Pupil

This school is funded through a combination of Federal and State/Local funds. The amounts in the bar graphs below are the dollars spent per student, broken down by source of funds. The amount of money spent per student depends on many factors, including student enrollment, staffing, special programs, and whether the school receives State or Federal grant funds.



How Does My School Spend Its Funds?

This school spends money on four types of Personnel and Non-Personnel costs: Instruction, Instructional Support, Operations, and Leadership.



Instruction Personnel: Includes salaries and benefits of staff providing direct instruction to students (teachers, teacher aids, substitutes, instructional paraprofessional in the classroom).

Instructional Support Non-personnel: All other costs associated with preparing pupils to learn, preparing teachers to be effective educators, and administering programs to reap student improvements.

Instruction Non-personnel: Includes instructional materials and supplies as well as pupil-use technology and software.

Operations Personnel: Central services (accounting, finance, human resources), facilities, transportation and food services personnel, and safety/security.

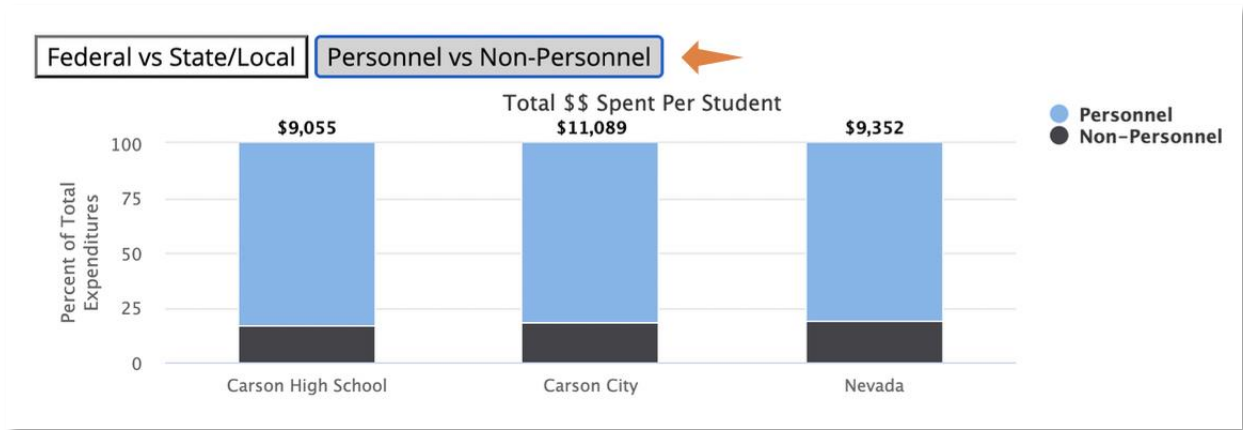
Leadership Non-personnel: School and district administrative office supplies, copier leases and maintenance agreements, postage, legal services

Instructional Support Non-personnel: All other costs associated with preparing pupils to learn, preparing teachers to be effective educators, and administering programs to reap student improvements.

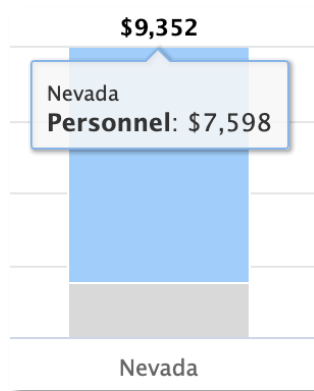
