

# Nevada's 2023 Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) Schools

#### **Overview**

Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) schools meet designation criteria under Nevada's federally-approved Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Plan. All Indicators in the Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF) have multiple Measures and each Measure is disaggregated by ten (10) student groups (American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander, Two or More Races, White, English Learners Current and Former, Students with Disabilities, and Economically Disadvantaged Students). ATSI schools have very low performance by one or more student groups in the identification year that, on their own, would lead to a Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) designation. The ATSI schools list identifies schools eligible for supports and interventions.

### 2018, 2019, and 2022 Eligibility Criteria

Criteria used in 2022 and prior years identified schools as TSI/ATSI based on the following criteria. Schools were designated as TSI if they had consistently underperforming groups of students within the Academic Achievement Indicator <u>AND</u> two other Indicators (Growth, Graduation Rate, English Language Proficiency, and Student Engagement). A consistently underperforming student group was a student group that did not meet performance targets two years in a row. These performance targets were:

- The Measures of Interim Progress (MIPs) for ELA and math proficiency, as well as 4- and 5-year graduation rates.
  - These MIPs are unique for each subgroup and each year.
  - For ELA and math proficiency, an alternative target to meeting the MIPs is for a subgroup to decrease non-proficiency by at least 10% over the prior year's performance.
- The lowest point-earning category on the point attribution tables (PATs) for Measures in the NSPF that do not have associated MIPs.
  - This corresponds to the state's 15<sup>th</sup> percentile of statewide student performance.

Schools were designated as TSI/ATSI if they were designated as TSI in the identification year and had one or more very low-performing student groups that did not meet targets that were representative of CSI school performance.

## 2023 Eligibility Criteria

Per changes to Nevada's federally-approved Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Plan, the criteria for ATSI identification changed substantially in 2023. ATSI schools have very low subgroup performance in the identification year that, on their own, would lead to a Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) designation. To determine this, an adjusted NSPF Score was generated for each student group at each school using all applicable NSPF rules, and then this adjusted score was then compared to the CSI Criteria to determine if that performance, on its own, would lead to a CSI designation. ### 2018, 2019, and 2022 School Cohorts

Once a school is identified as a TSI/ATSI school, it will remain a part of that cohort for four years, including a designation year followed by a three-year improvement phase. The first cohort of TSI/ATSI schools were identified in 2018 (elementary and middle schools only). High schools were first identified for TSI/ATSI designations in 2019. The first exit evaluations for TSI/ATSI schools will occur in Summer 2024.

### **2023 School Cohorts**

Schools identified as ATSI will remain a part of the ATSI cohort for three years unless they meet CSI Criteria and are redesignated during that period. At the end of the three-year period, schools will be evaluated for exit. More information on exit criteria can be found in the NSPF manual found on the Nevada Report Card.

# **Column Header Descriptions**

**School Number:** The number used to identify schools. The number after the period indicates the school's level (.1 = ES, .2 = MS, .3 = HS).

**District:** The school district of the identified school. Charter schools that are sponsored by the State Public Charter School Authority are listed as "SPCSA" while school district-sponsored charter schools are listed under their school district sponsor.

**School:** The name of the identified school.

**2023 Star Rating:** NSPF Star Ratings were calculated for 2022-23.

**2023 Index Score (Out of 100):** The total number of points, out of 100, a school earned in 2023. Details on how these points are earned can be found on the Nevada Accountability Portal.

Student Group/s Identified as Meeting ATSI Criteria: This column identifies the student groups that triggered the ATSI Designation.
