As a community, we will instill in every child a vision to graduate, providing a comprehensive, safe, challenging and effective learning environment that prepares students to be career and college ready.

Superintendent's Highlights

Humboldt County School District, a rural school district serving approximately 3,400 students supported by 440 staff members has much to celebrate in our journey towards academic excellence. With 11 unique school sites, 4 of which are considered remote rural, HCSD is committed to providing and ensuring equitable educational opportunities for all students. With a committed administrative staff at each individual school site, supported by district administration and the board of trustees, the district has enjoyed significant progress in meeting its identified vision statement in which all students will graduate, college and career ready. Specific highlights from the 2018-2019 school year include:

- Continued commitment and progress on the district's 5-year Strategic Plan
 - Historical high graduation rate of 90.34% for the 2018 cohort
 - Expansion of Distance Education opportunities providing non-traditional educational opportunities for interested students and families
 - Implementation of new curriculum across all grade levels
 - McDermitt Combined Schools, an identified Victory School, met a 100% graduation rate

 - Recognition of a number of athletic teams as academic state champions
 - Strong commitment to the Boys and Girls Club of Winnemucca to support after school and summer school programming

 - Intensive mental health services provided through the Family Support Center (FSC) supported through the successful Project Aware grant

District Communication Efforts

Humboldt County School District (HCSD) continues to provide parents of all students with many opportunities for discourse and educational opportunities for its families. While each school is unique, similar veins run through them all. Infinite Campus, our student information system seems to be the most timely and relevant information to all parents as it communicates in real time their child's attendance, grades, lunch funds, and calendar of events. Messages via text, email, and phone continue to be communicated through IC.

HCSD continues to use Facebook as our social media presence. All schools have a Facebook page in addition to the district's page. Through these pages, we continue to provide the most relevant and timely information both district and site specific. We communicate emergency posts, award notices, student and staff recognitions, upcoming events, and more.

Peachjar is our electronic email communication system to replace the days of copying and sending home paper flyers.

Dr. Jensen, HCSD Superintendent continues to write an article for the local newspaper on a monthly basis as a way to communicate important topics related to education in general or HCSD hot topics of interest. The newspaper also provides us a spotlight section each month where our schools and the district can highlight stories, successful events, student and teacher work and more through a page titled Sensational Schools. Dr. Jensen also continues to have air time with our local radio station which is helpful for transparent communication.

HCSD has a district level staff member who has a job responsibility that includes that of Parent/Family Engagement coordinator.

This staff member has worked closely with our learning strategists at the elementary schools specifically to support parents in helping with reading initiatives in the home. School Title I funds were used this year to split a parent engagement coordinator position between two of the elementary schools and was helpful directly impacting parents at the school sites. Morning Mugs in which parents came in one day a week and received PD on a variety of topics such as supporting your struggling reader, the summer slide and how to avoid it to name just a few topics was a hit! We look forward to an expansion this coming year.

Discipline

HCSD takes pride in providing a safe and supportive environment for students, parents and staff. Efforts at all grade levels are made to support positive reinforcement and to deter negative student behaviors. Administrators and staff work to not only be compliant with the law, yet to also educate students and parents on ensuring students feel safe in our schools.

HCSD continues to have an online link for a person to report any allegations or concerns of bullying which is automatically received at the district office and passed along to the appropriate site administration to conduct an investigation if they don't feel safe reporting at the site level. In addition, SafeVoice was introduced across our sites and was used as another avenue for all people to report either anonymously or not.

HCSD has PBIS at 10 of our school sites through the School Climate Transformation grant to include even our K-8 remote rural schools. This commitment to PBIS has helped our staff and students be clear about expectations and helped us focus on teaching expectations. Part of Tier I PBIS includes bullying prevention training for the teams. Project AWARE funds have also been utilized to develop school climate teams who are developing social emotional plans to help all students.
