## Superintendent's Highlights

### Three Washoe County School Students (WCSD) Win National Merit Scholarships

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation awarded three high school seniors from WCSD university-funded scholarships for the 2022-2023 school year. The students were named finalists in the competition for their accomplishments, skills, and potential for success in rigorous college studies. They were chosen among 7,500 high school seniors who received nearly \$28 million in scholarships. Each student received between \$500 and \$2,000 annually for up to four years of undergraduate study at the institution financing the scholarship. ### Reno High School Senior Awarded National Merit Scholarship

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) announced that a high school senior from WCSD was awarded a scholarship for the 2022-23 school year. Dylan Oliver, who graduated from Reno High School, was named a finalist in the scholarship competition for his accomplishments, skills, and potential for success in rigorous college studies. He was chosen from among 15,000 semi-finalists nationwide and will receive \$2,500. He plans to study physics in college.

### Reno High School's "We the People" Team Ranks in Top 12 in America

Reno High School's "We the People" team performed admirably in the national competition and now ranks 12th in the country for this academically rigorous and prestigious annual event. Reno High School's team, led by instructor Richard Clark, competed virtually from the University of Nevada, Reno.

### WCSD Fifth Grade Teacher Wins Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics, and Science Teaching

A fifth-grade teacher from Nick Poulakidas Elementary School, Amie Braik, represented Nevada as the winner of the Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics, and Science Teaching (PAEMST) for 2020. Amie Braik has been an educator for 17 years, the last seven in the WCSD (WCSD). Established in 1983, PAEMST is the highest award kindergarten through 12th-grade math, and science teachers can receive from the U.S. government.

### Eight Schools from WCSD Rank Among Nevada's Top 30 High Schools

U.S. News & World Report issued its annual rankings of 18,000 public high schools in 50 states and the District of Columbia. Ryan Smith M.Ed., Vaughn Middle School, Assistant Principal, won a national award, which recognized the work of professionals who advocate for world languages in education.

### **North Valleys High School Teacher Chosen for NASA Airborne Astronomy Ambassador Program**

James Young from North Valleys H.S. is among an elite group of 24 teachers from 13 states chosen to participate in the 2022 NASA Airborne Astronomy Ambassadors(AAA). James has taught Astronomy, Physics, and Mathematics for WCSD since 2014. AAA is a professional development program for science teachers to improve science teaching and enhance student learning and STEM engagement. The AAA program includes middle, high, and community college teachers.

### **Reno High School JROTC Team Shines in World Robotics Competition**

A team of seven students representing Reno High School's JROTC program ranks in the top 16 teams in the JROTC category at Worlds Robotics Championships in Dallas, Texas. The competition was held at the Dallas Convention Center, where the Huskies competed against 80 other JROTC teams. This is the second year Reno High School's JROTC cadets have had a robotics team and the second time the team has entered a world competition where more than 40 countries showcase their skills in robotics.

### **Brown Elementary School Earns National Recognition as Model Professional Learning Community at Work**

For the third consecutive year, Brown Elementary School has earned national recognition as a Model Professional Learning Community at Work (PLC) by Solution Tree. Educators in the schools and districts selected for this elite recognition have shown a sustained commitment to helping all their students achieve high levels. Brown Elementary School was the only school in Nevada to earn this recognition in 2021.

### **Spanish Springs High School JROTC Cougar Battalion Brings Home National Honors**

The Spanish Springs High School Army JROTC Cougar Battalion earned national recognition at the U.S. Army JROTC Raider Nationals competition in Molena, Georgia. Forty cadets from the Cougar Battalion competed in various events, including a physical team test, 5k run, gauntlet, and rope bridge. Cougar Battalion earned second place honors overall in the 5k race for the male team. The female team finished in the top five in three out of four event categories. Cadet Joliette Johnson achieved the title of Ultimate Rader Champion.

### **Incline High School Teacher Named Extraordinary Educator in 2021 Spotlight Awards**

Milton Hyams, Incline High School U.S. Government Teacher, and Team Leader, was named the 2021 PBS Spotlight Award Winner for Extraordinary Educator. Milton was nominated and chosen by the community for 22 years of work and service to the students of Incline High School and 25 years overall in WCSD.

### **Governor Sisolak and Superintendent Ebert Honor 2022 Nevada Teacher of the Year**

Deanne Moyle-Hicks, a 4th-grade teacher at Natchez E.S. and a National Board-Certified teacher, was named 2022 Nevada Teacher of the Year.

### **WCSD Board of Trustees Appoints Dr. Susan Enfield as New Superintendent of Schools**

During a special public meeting, the WCSD Board of Trustees appointed Dr. Susan Enfield to serve as superintendent of the WCSD. Superintendent Dr. Kristen McNeill retired on June 30.

### **Nevada Association of School Boards Recognizes Outstanding Contributions of WCSD Staff, Community Partners**

The Nevada Association of School Boards (NASB) bestowed three prestigious awards on staff members and partners of WCSD. WCSD Chief Operating Officer Pete Etchart, Roy Gomm Elementary School teacher Marcell Boyer, and the Food Bank of Northern Nevada. Chief Operating Officer Pete Etchart received the District Level Administrator Impacting Student Achievement Award for overseeing Facilities Management, Nutrition Services, and Transportation for the District's 62,000 students. Veteran teacher Marcell Boyer was awarded the Innovative Educator of the Year Award. Boyer has taught for WCSD since 1995 and currently teaches second grade at Roy Gomm Elementary School. NASB awarded the Food Bank of Northern Nevada (FBNN) the recognition for Individual Friend of K-12 Public Instruction. FBNN has worked in partnership with WCSD for many years, helping to support students and families with vital food resources throughout the year.

### **Education Alliance Presents \$102,400 to WCSD Elementary Schools for Student Health and Wellness**

Education Alliance of WCSD expanded its fundraising efforts for physical and nutritional health to include support for mental health resources for WCSD students with the Healing through Health initiative. Education Alliance awarded \$1,600 each to 64 WCSD elementary schools.

### **Notable Grant Awards for SY 2021-22**

- **American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Response (ESSER III) funds - \$77M.** After gathering input from the community, students, parents, teachers, and administrators, WCSD is using this funding in five major areas: Direct Student Instruction, Direct Student Social & Emotional Support, Teacher Support, Family Support, and

District Support. Funding includes more teachers in the classroom to reduce class sizes in core subject areas (ELA, math, science), intervention teachers, tutoring, social workers, counselors, attendance support, support for families, training for teachers and administrators, PPE, student technology, web-based instructional programs, support for charter schools, and COVID differentials for employees.

- **FCC Emergency Connectivity Fund - \$2,000,000.** To purchase laptops for student and staff use. The Program provides funding to schools and libraries for purchasing laptop and tablet computers, Wi-Fi hotspots, routers, modems, and broadband connections for use by students and school staff at locations other than the school during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Duffield Foundation – \$707,673.** Support Personalized Learning at Incline High School, including reducing class sizes and providing teacher training.

### **WCSD Receives 20th Consecutive Recognition for Achievement in Procurement**

For the 20th consecutive year, the WCSD procurement team won an award for excellence from the National Procurement Institute (NPI), Inc. This is the 24th time the District has received the Annual Achievement of Excellence in Procurement Award, which honors innovation, professionalism, productivity, e-procurement, and leadership attributes. WCSD was one of only 19 school districts – to receive the award this year.

### **WCSD Passes Fourth Straight Balanced General Fund Budget**

On May 24, 2022, the Board of Trustees approved the fourth straight structurally balanced General Fund budget for the District. A structurally balanced budget is one in which ongoing revenues are equal to or greater than ongoing expenditures. The District's total budget exceeds \$1 billion.

### **WCSD Maintains Favorable Financial Ratings**

WCSD has maintained its favorable ratings from Moody's Investor Service and Standard & Poor's Ratings Services. Moody's Investors Service and Standard & Poor's (S&P) reaffirmed the WCSD's "AA" bond ratings. S&P has rated the District's long-term debt as "AA", while Moody's rating of the District is "Aa3."

### **WCSD Middle School -Awarded Project of the Year by the American Public Works Association**

Marce Herz Middle School, a new \$73 million middle school in south Reno that accommodates 1,400 6th-8th grade students won the American Public Works (APWA) Project of the Year Award in the category of "Structures, Greater than \$20M" after submitting a project writeup and giving a presentation at the APWA Fall Conference in South Lake Tahoe.

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## **Goals and Objectives**

- Ensure annual student academic growth through a system of curriculum, instruction, and assessment that is aligned, rigorous, and relevant. Instruction will be designed to meet the needs of every child in our diverse student population.
- To develop and retain highly effective personnel who are driven to support students and their academic success as well as the success of the District. The Washoe County School District will accomplish this goal through recruitment, selection, professional development, and training.
- Engage family, staff, Trustees, and community members in strong relationships, provide meaningful opportunities to increase their educational expertise and trust, and share responsibility for student success.
- Provide and continuously improve operational systems that are effective, efficient, transparent, and accountable by using meaningful structures and processes.
- Ensure our schools are safe, secure, supportive, and welcoming environments where students and staff are able to succeed academically and professionally at the highest possible levels

## **District Communication Efforts**

The following was accomplished in family engagement during the 21-22 school year in support of the Washoe County School District's (WCSD) strategic plan and in response to learning during the pandemic. The Title I Department, the Department of Family-School Partnerships (FSP), the Office of Academics, the Office of Strategies and the Department of Child & Family Services collaborated to implement district-wide initiatives for family engagement that included:

- The Child and Family Services Department focused on reestablishing relationships and community building. Due to the pandemic, it was recognized that some families were not able to have access to their child's school site so the department focused on making connections with them at the time of enrollment. Families were invited to attend an introduction to meet program staff and learn about the EC program. These meetings were provided in English and Spanish, and families received a calendar of upcoming events and resources to help support learning at home. The resources included children's books and school supplies. Family Engagement Specialists provided in-person and online workshops on topics that supported school readiness activities. Families connected with each other during the small in-person and online workshops. Families appreciated being able to connect with the other families. The Family Engagement Specialists collaborated with the FACE Liaisons at schools so they could connect families with the school and community resources. The EC teachers worked with their families through class meetings, providing home visits, parents volunteering and daily communication.
- Title I funded and provided supports to Family and Community Engagement (FACE) liaisons hired at district Title I schools to provide families academic support and fulfill the vision of family engagement in ESEA.
- FACE liaisons worked collaboratively with the 21st Century Team Up afterschool site coordinators to align family

engagement events and activities at their school sites. There were 25 Title I schools in the 21-22 school year that had after-school programming.

- The following professional learning on family engagement was provided for support staff, teachers and administrators: novice teachers received support in reflecting on core beliefs, communication and building family capacity to support learning, teachers seeking licensure requirements were supported with two semester-long courses from Northwest Regional Professional Development Program, two Alternative Routes to Licensure cohorts were supported with an 8-hour family engagement class, Family Graduation Advocates were supported with monthly PLC meetings and semi-annual professional learning session focused on relevant topics such as mental health, student motivation and high school credit recovery options. FACE liaisons, Family Graduation Advocates (FGA), and Student Graduation Advocates also received training on the Pathway to Education for DACA and mixed status families, being able to rethink and reframe hard conversations, and identify resources and learn how colleagues in other departments support families. Certified and support staff at 27 participating Parent Teacher Home Visit schools received professional learning on virtual bridge visits and how to safely conduct in-person home visits. Elementary teachers from 7 elementary schools participated in professional learning as part of the Parent University Family Literacy Club cohort.
- FACE and high school Family Graduation Advocates' academic contacts were tracked with families in the Infinite Campus Student Information System in order to reflect on which families we are successfully connecting with and plan for continuous improvement, focusing the FACE and FGA positions on equitable outreach, supporting families with their child's academic achievement and development. FACE Liaisons received virtual training on WIDA levels and assessments, Washoe County Library System, LGBTQ+ Supports, and B.I.G. data warehouse training along with virtual one-on-one and area meetings on a regular basis.
- FSP continued the 10th year of WCSD Parent University, collaborating with various district and community partners to shift practice meeting the virtual needs of families with the full reopening of schools in the Fall of 2021. Parent U offered classes both virtually and when it was safe, in-person. More than 40 different topics were offered and included areas such as: family emotional wellness, transition to kindergarten, middle, high school and post-secondary, social media and internet safety, early literacy, math and STEM. Parent University also collaborated with teacher leaders to support a cohort of teachers with Family Literacy Clubs. Teachers were first provided with professional learning and collaboration time to understand the research and practice with family engagement. Teachers then hosted Family Literacy Clubs with their own families and were supported with technology supports, funding for take-home supplies and interpretation support.
- The Family Stability group, a partnership between WCSD, UNR College of Education, Human Development and Family Studies, TMCC and various community partners including the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Community Health Alliance, Communities in Schools and various other partners continued to study IEL's Full-Service Community Schools model to further develop and strengthen this comprehensive model in various neighborhoods and communities. This collaborative has prepared a grant proposal for three pilot schools for the USDOE's Full-Service Community Schools grant. The committee also collaborated to write a private grant to begin the Parent Leadership Training Institute with Faith in Action Nevada.
- The Department of English Language Development continued to support new families in the community who were seeking refuge in partnership with Northern Nevada's International Center, providing families with individual support in the transition to school and connecting families with current resources to support their navigation of the educational system. The ELD Department, RISE Academy for Adult Achievement and FSP planned for the opening of a New Family Welcome Center for the 22-23 school year.
- The district resumed its district-wide Family Climate Survey in the spring of 2022.
- FSP shifted support for the Parent Teacher Home Visit Program in 28 schools to implement virtual Bridge Visits with families focusing on relationships, hopes and dreams. FSP staff members and teacher leaders provided school staff members with 6 different professional learning sessions to support understanding in shifting to virtual visits. FSP provided monthly coaching for school site PTHV Champions/Site Coordinator.
- Title VI supported Native families by providing devices during exclusions, outreach events with school supplies, culturally responsive summer reading materials, individual student coaching and family support through Student Graduation Advocates and support through collaboration with both Reno Sparks Indian Colony and Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.

## Discipline

The mission of the Ombudsman & Strategies Office is to provide system-wide leadership for a unified approach to fostering climate and student engagement. An engaging climate which optimizes learning is one in which students, families, and staff share a sense of belongingness, is inclusive, and one in which equitable practices and collaboration prevail. This requires coordination between many office departments including our Equity & Diversity Department, our MTSS-SEL Department, our Intervention Department, our Family Schools Partnership Department, Our Counseling Department and Social Work Division, and our Behavioral Divisions. It also requires cross-office collaboration with the Office of Accountability, Office of Academics, and the Office of School Leadership.

Our Behavior Division works on an ongoing basis with school site administration focusing on preventative measures and non-traditional forms of discipline. Working collaboratively with schools and multiple stakeholders, we have developed our behavioral manual and behavioral matrix which provides clear guidance and expectations regarding disciplinary practices. A major emphasis of this work is to decrease the number of major behavioral incidents, including the number of incidents related to bullying or cyber bullying, and to reduce the use of out of school suspensions, as appropriate. It also places a premium on non-traditional disciplinary strategies such as Restorative Justice.

In response to revisions to NRS 392.4644 and other related sections, the District:

- Updated WCSD Policy to reflect the changes
- Updated guidance manuals and procedures to support schools regarding changes
- Provide ongoing training to all school administrators regarding the changes
- Worked with the Washoe Education Association and other associations to provide information regarding the legislative changes

The WCSD continues to examine student behavior, school climate and safety data through an equity lens. All schools participate in climate and safety surveys annually, which include parents, students and staff results. Reports are issued to all schools with opportunities to interpret information. Periodic time is spent with schools examining discipline outcomes and disproportionality.

### Department of Civil Rights Compliance

The Department of Civil Rights Compliance (DCRC) has the following responsibilities:

- Update Board Policies, Administrative Regulations and Procedures to ensure the District is in compliance with federal and state civil rights and bullying laws.
- Oversee the process for filing and resolving complaints and appeals regarding bullying and Title IX.
- Present training and act as a resource to school administrators responsible for investigating bullying and Title IX complaints.
- Work with the Nevada Department of Education and the federal Department of Education, Office of Civil Rights to resolve complaints filed with these agencies.

As an on-going practice the WCSD engages in providing a Behavioral Matrix which also serves as the WCSD's Progressive Discipline Plan. This document is designed to support administrator's in providing consistency in disciplinary consequences. This document is reviewed and revised by a multi-disciplinary team and all administrators have the opportunity to receive training on the Behavioral Matrix on an annual basis.

### Curriculum Details

- developing professional learning that honors teachers and provides content expertise to the District.
