Superintendent's Highlights

Assessment Results:

Nevada completed all assessments for the 2023-24 school yearand will provide all assessment results on the Nevada Accountability Portal as mandated. Districts and schools are required to meet the 95% participation raterequirement for Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA) CriterionReferenced (CRT) assessments. Nevada will report assessment results for 2023-24and this will be the third consecutive school year of statewide assessmentssince the COVID 19 pandemic in spring 2020. While the results are an importantindicator of academic achievement, they may not necessarily be comparable toassessment results prior to the pandemic.

Graduation Rates:

The four-year graduation rate decreased for the Class of 2023to 81.4 percent. That is down from 81.7 percent the year before. In 12 ofNevada's 17 school districts as well as the State Public Charter SchoolAuthority (SPCSA), students graduated at a higher rate than the State average 81.4 percent. Nine of Nevada's 17 school districts showed increases ingraduation rates from the previous year, with Storey School District showingthe highest gain. Other districts with year-to-year increases in graduation rates include Churchill County School District, Clark County School District, Douglas County School District, Elko County School District, Lander County School District, Lyon County School District, and Mineral County School District

NSPF Star Ratings:The Nevada Department of Education (NDE) calculated the Nevada School Performance (NSPF) Star Ratings. The Index Scores provided for all NSPF indicators and measures were calculated using 2023-24 accountability data.

Federal School Designations:

The NDE designated schools for Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) and Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) based on 2023-24 school year studentperformance data.

Academic Growth and Closing Opportunity Gaps:

Academic growth for elementary and middle schools is calculatedusing two consecutive years of data. Nevada continues to analyze assessmentdata for both 2022-23 and 2023-24 school years to ensure that the State's OtherAcademic Indicators meet minimum n size requirements as well as equalrepresentation of student populations across districts and schools.
