Superintendent's Highlights

The Elko County School District is home to the families of approximately 9,700 students and over 1,100 employees. Located within the county boundaries are 7 distinct communities spread across over 17,000 sq miles, making it the 4th largest geographic school district in the contiguous United States. This includes schools ranging from several 1-room schoolhouses to K-12 combined schools, to a high school with over 1,400 students. Among these, three are 21st Century Learning Center Schools and seven are Title I. We were excited to break ground to begin the construction of the brand-new Owyhee Combined School on the Duck Valley Indian Reservation and look forward to its completion in a couple more years. One of our K-12 combined schools received a Governor's designation as a Developing STEM School for its efforts in providing STEM learning experiences to its students, aiding in the state's efforts to diversify its economy by teaching, training, and recruiting STEM industry professionals. ECSD enjoys strong partnerships and community collaborations with such entities as Nevada Gold Mines and Kinross Bald Mountain, who provide much financial and volunteer support to schools all across the county. The Elko Federal Credit Union, Elko County Sheriff's Office, and the Elko Police Department are essential in supporting our students and faculty from a physical and mental health and safety perspective. The school district also provided 10 mental health webinars, unlimited parent coaching, and on-demand parent courses for all families in our county. It implemented Hope Squad, a peer-to-peer suicide prevention class, in all secondary schools. Ten of our school sites are supported by Communities in Schools to bring needed assistance and resources to those students, families, and staff. Coordination with Spread the Word Nevada and the Dolly Parton Imagination Library helps us put books in kids' hands, build family libraries, and emphasize the importance of literacy from an early age. Each one of our sites is proud to be a 1:1 technology school, putting digital resources in every student's hand, including access to 24/7 unlimited and multilingual tutoring and academic support. All these services, among others, help foster safe and respectful learning environments and support the whole student socially and emotionally. ECSD enjoys students and staff whose backgrounds and demographics are just as diverse as the types of schools they attend. With so many unique communities and makeups, it is no wonder that the ECSD has so many different and wonderful accomplishments to celebrate. We offer 40 CTE programs that serve well over half of our students in those grade levels. From the classroom to co-curricular activities and student organizations, to the field of competition in athletics, our students and staff shine bright. Among the many noteworthy celebrations are such items as one student who was chosen nationally to attend the Joint Science and Technology Institute, five high school graduates who started internships and concurrent enrollment with Tesla and TMCC, the Nevada Scholastic Challenge 6th and 8th Grade State Champions, several recipients of the Scholastic Art Award and others who had their artwork displayed at an international art exhibit and a cohort of students with a 100% pass rate on the National Career Readiness Credential exams. These students are supported by so many amazing and dedicated staff who are just as accomplished themselves, including the Nevada Rural STEM Teacher of the Year and Nevada School Nurse Administrator of the Year. Our students and staff also excelled on the field, court, and track, with two of our teams winning State Championships in cross country and wrestling, and three teams earning the honor of State Academic Champions in baseball, cross country, and spirit. Another one of our schools won the coveted NIAA Award of Excellence for their whole athletic program. The Elko County School District is immensely proud of our students, staff, and all stakeholders in our school community who make Elko County schools a wonderful place to learn, succeed, and pursue your dreams. Annual Performance Objective 1: 100% of the professional development opportunities provided to teachers, staff, and administrators during the 2024-2025 school year will include an evaluation component which will be gathered and analyzed for alignment with district goals and priorities. Annual Performance Objective 2: ECSD has developed a 7 year curriculum adoption cycle. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year and extending through the 2028-2029 school year, ECSD will execute the planned curriculum adoption with 100% fidelity. Goal 3: Connectedness- Our Individual health and collective wellness are essential to our success. Annual Performance Objective 1: The Fall 2023 administration of the Nevada Social Emotional School Climate Survey (NV-SCSEL) indicates that the district average in the social emotional competencies domain is 72%. By the Fall 2024 administration of this survey the district average will increase to 75%. Annual Performance Objective 2: As measured by the Fall 2023 administration of the Nevada Social Emotional School Climate Survey (NV-SCSEL), when asked "I feel like I belong." the percentage of ECSD students responding either "Strongly Agree" or "Agree" is 72%. By the Fall 2024 administration of this survey this percentage will increase to 75%.

District Communication Efforts

Our relationships with families and the community are productive and meaningful. Communication to ECSD families and larger communities is a multi-tiered responsibility shared across our District. Ongoing and positive communication that affects a large group of students, or our entire student community, is sent from the District Office using newsletters, text messages, voice calls, the website, and app alert system. These communications include the promotion of family engagement activities, wellness events, notices and alerts. ECSD actively promotes ongoing dialogue with parents and guardians by asking for feedback on important decisions, policy, and programming through the use of surveys and public forums. We encourage engagement with the Board of Trustees by providing video summaries of board meetings and making the videos widely available on social media platforms and email. The ECSD Family and Community Engagement Center (FACE) provides Family Liaisons based at all Title I schools. Additionally, this year, Public Relations Liaisons were a new stipend position at each school whose responsibilities included sharing information on the schools' website, app and social pages.

Discipline

Safevoice is used district wide. Hope Squad - suicide mainly but also used for bullying. Bullying curriculum is utilized through counselors as well.

Technology

Elko County School District is a 1-to-1 district, which means every student has a device. All of the student and staff devices are on a refresh schedule. We have a Digital Coordinator who helps train the teachers with the digital curriculum and tools we have purchased for them to use. We run reports for our purchased curriculum and tool to gather usage statistics, and scores if available.

Curriculum Details

We utilize state approved curriculum in all grade levels and subject areas. We are currently restarting our textbook adoption process for all subject areas and grade levels on a 7 year rotating basis to replace some old curriculum. New purchases were paused for a period of time due to budget constraints. We purchased new math curriculum for all courses and grades last year and have purchased new foreign language curriculum this year with other subjects to follow. We only purchase curriculum approved by the state board of education.
