### Superintendent's Highlights

#### Assessment Results:

Nevada completed all assessments for the 2024-25 school year and provided all assessment results on the Nevada Accountability Portal as mandated. Districts and schools are required to meet the 95% participation rate requirement for Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA) Criterion Referenced (CRT) assessments. Nevada reported assessment results for 2024-25 and this will be the fourth consecutive school year of statewide assessments since the COVID 19 pandemic in spring 2020. While the results are an important indicator of academic achievement, they may not necessarily be comparable to assessment results prior to the pandemic.

#### Graduation Rates:

The four-year graduation rate increased for the Class of 2024 to 81.6 percent. That is up from 81.4 percent the year before. In 14 of Nevada's 17 school districts as well as the State Public Charter School Authority (SPCSA), students graduated at a higher rate than the State average of 81.6 percent. Nine of Nevada's 17 school districts showed increases in graduation rates from the previous year, with Esmeralda County School District showing the highest gain. Other districts with year-to-year increases in graduation rates include Carson City School District, Douglas County School District, Lincoln County School District, Lyon County School District, Mineral County School District, Nye County School District, Washoe County School District, and White Pine County School District.

#### NSPF Star Ratings:

The Nevada Department of Education (NDE) calculated the Nevada School Performance (NSPF) Star Ratings for the 2024-2025 school year. The Index Scores resulting from points earned for NSPF indicators and their associated measures were calculated using the accountability data from the 2024-2025 school year.

#### Federal School Designations:

Based on 2024-2025 school year student performance data, NDE has identified schools for the following federal designations:

- Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI),
- Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI),
- Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI)

Some schools successfully met the established exit criteria and have exited their previous designation status. Additionally, some schools were released from the ATSI designation due to changes in the NSPF business rules for the 2023-2024 school year. Specifically, schools that were previously identified for ATSI solely based on the performance of the English Learner (EL) student group – including former ELs – may no longer meet the identification criteria under the updated methodology, which now excludes former ELs from student group calculations.

#### Academic Growth and Closing Opportunity Gaps:

Academic growth for elementary and middle schools is calculated using two consecutive years of data. Nevada continues to analyze assessment data for both 2023-24 and 2024-25 school years to ensure that the State's Other Academic Indicators meet minimum n size requirements as well as equal representation of student populations across districts and schools.
