### Superintendent's Highlights

As we reflect on another school year in Elko County, we are proud of the strides made across our diverse communities—from new academic opportunities to capital investments and expanded student supports. The 2024–2025 school year continued our momentum of innovation, collaboration, and service. Below are highlights from this past year: Two of our largest capital improvement projects gained community excitement and significant progress: the construction of the new Owyhee Combined School and the AgriScience building at Spring Creek High School. Groundwork is well underway in Owyhee, marking a long-anticipated milestone in modernizing facilities for our most rural learners. At Spring Creek, the new AgriScience building is set to open with a ribbon cutting scheduled for September, offering students access to hands-on agricultural education in a state-of-the-art space. Districtwide, our student-to-teacher ratios remain relatively low compared to previous years, supporting a strong learning environment and more individualized instruction: Kindergarten: 17:1? 1st Grade: 19:1? 2nd Grade: 21:1? 3rd Grade: 22:1? 4th Grade: 21:1? 5th Grade: 23:1? 6th Grade: 20:1? These numbers reflect our ongoing efforts to recruit and retain educators while balancing enrollment and funding challenges. Elko High School senior Kyara Hernandez-Duarte represented our county and state with excellence, winning the Elko County Poetry Out Loud Contest, the Nevada state competition, and traveling to Washington, D.C. to perform on the national stage. Spring Creek High School launched a new Fire Science Career and Technical Education (CTE) program for the 2024–2025 school year, made possible by the Elko County Fire Protection District. This program blends classroom learning with practical labs and helps students earn industry-recognized credentials, strengthening our CTE pipeline. Mountain View Elementary School earned national recognition, one of only five schools across the U.S. to receive a \$10,000 grant from the American Heart Association and NFL for a P.E. classroom makeover, plus an additional \$5,000 in equipment from the Las Vegas Raiders and a visit from the Raiders Junior Training Camp. Our partnerships continue to make a difference: Nevada Gold Mines has renewed its commitment to the NGM School Grant Program, awarding \$80,000 to ECSD schools for the 2024–2025 year. This program fuels teacher-led innovation and supports projects directly impacting students. Additionally, Nevada Gold Mines is generously providing in-kind donations for an upcoming playground upgrade at Carlin Combined, set to begin soon. Students at West Wendover High School helped upgrade football field structures through their Building Trades and Welding classes. With support from the city, contractors, and a \$20,000 grant from Wells Rural Electric Company, the school continues to improve facilities and strengthen community pride. District leadership began the process of identifying the core competencies we believe every ECSD student should embody, working with students, staff, families, and community members to shape what will become our Portrait of a Learner. Policy progress was made this year with revisions to the district's cell phone use policy, involving community input and Board consideration. Community partners and donors continue to step up in support of our schools' playground and athletic facility needs. Recent contributions include Empire Cat and RAM Enterprises helping construct a new long jump pit and shot put area at Wells Combined. Our community engagement efforts included the second annual Back to School Resource Fair and ongoing collaboration with national and local organizations to provide wraparound support to families. Elko County School District is proud to serve 9,358 students in 22 schools across 17,100 square miles—making us the fourth-largest geographic school district in the contiguous United States. This year has been defined by resilience, creativity, and shared investment in our students' future. With gratitude for our educators, staff, families, and partners, we look forward to the continued progress ahead.

### Goals and Objectives

Goal 1: Student Success- Our students are empowered to own their learning, go anywhere and be anything. Annual Performance Objective 1: Increase the percentage of 2nd and 3rd grade students who are projected to be proficient or advanced on the SBAC Language Arts/Literacy assessment by 3 percentage points each year for the next three years as measured by the Spring MAP Growth Reading assessment: 2023-2024- from 32% to 35% 2024-2025- from 35% to 38% 2025-2026- from 38% to 41% Annual Performance Objective 2: Increase the percentage of 4th-7th grade students who are projected to be proficient or advanced on the SBAC Mathematics assessment by 3 percentage points each year for the next three years as measured by the Spring MAP Growth Mathematics assessment: 2023-2024- from 24.3% to 27.3% 2024-2025- from 27.3% to 30.3% 2025-2026- from 30.3% to 33.3% Goal 2: Adult Learning Culture- Our district and school leadership are committed to the highest quality of education, while being responsive to the unique needs of each learner. Annual Performance Objective 1: ECSD has developed a 7 year curriculum adoption cycle. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year and extending through the 2028-2029 school year, ECSD will execute the planned curriculum adoption with 100% fidelity. Goal 3: Connectedness- Our Individual health and collective wellness are essential to our success. Annual Performance Objective 1: As measured by the Fall 2024 administration of the Nevada Social Emotional School Climate Survey (NV-SCSEL), when asked "I feel like I belong," the percentage of ECSD students responding either "Strongly Agree" or "Agree" is 73%. By the Fall 2025 administration of this survey this percentage will increase to 75%.

### District Communication Efforts

Our relationships with families and the community are productive and meaningful. Communication to ECSD families and larger communities is a multi-tiered responsibility shared across our District. Ongoing and positive communication that affects a large group of students, or our entire student community, is sent from the District Office using newsletters, text messages, voice calls, the website, and app alert system. These communications include the promotion of family engagement activities, wellness events, notices and alerts. ECSD actively promotes ongoing dialogue with parents and guardians by asking for feedback on important decisions, policy, and programming through the use of surveys and public forums. We encourage engagement with the Board of Trustees by providing video summaries of board meetings and making the videos widely available on social media platforms and email. The ECSD Family and Community Engagement Center (FACE) provides Family Liaisons based at all Title I schools. Additionally, this year, Public Relations Liaisons were a new stipend position at each school whose responsibilities included sharing information on the schools' website, app and social pages.

### Discipline

SafeVoice is used district wide. Hope Squad - suicide mainly but also used for bullying. Bullying curriculum is utilized through counselors as well.

### Access to Menstrual Products

All students have access to maxipads and/or tampons free of charge at every school in the Elko County School District.

### Technology

Elko County School District is a 1-to-1 district, which means every student has a device. All of the student and staff devices are on a refresh schedule. We have a Digital Coordinator who helps train the teachers with the digital curriculum and tools we have purchased for them to use. We run reports for our purchased curriculum and tool to gather usage statistics, and scores if available.

### Curriculum Details

We utilize state approved curriculum in all grade levels and subject areas. We are recurrently restarting our textbook adoption process for all subject areas and grade levels on a 7 year rotating basis to replace some old curriculum. New last year and purchased new science curriculum this year with other subjects to follow. We only purchase curriculum approved by the state board of education.
